


NPSpecies Redesigned Data Schema

Capabilities of New Data Schema

- Flexibility Built into NPSpecies 3.0 Database Schema for Future Use
 - Ability to add new Park Status Attributes and Values without changing database structure.
 - Lifecycle states track records through workflow between users.
 - Ability to flag a species in a park as confidential.
 - Ability to save snapshots of species lists by park over time.
- New Additions to Data Schema
 - Park-Species links to References, Vouchers, and Observations
 - Recertification events
 - Certification participants
 - Identification of data ready for public release
