

Arkansas Post NMem Deer Monitoring

White-tailed deer were monitored between 2005 and 2011 on Arkansas Post National Memorial, Arkansas using methods developed by the Heartland Inventory and Monitoring Network. See: <http://science.nature.nps.gov/im/units/htln/deer.cfm>. An index of deer density was used to identify annual changes in the deer population within the survey area of the park. The annual indexes of deer density values demonstrate an up-and-down oscillation pattern since the start of surveys in 2005. In 2011, the index of deer density was on a downward oscillation. However, the resulting index value remained 33% above the average value across all years.
