

NPS AlaskaPak Toolkit v2.2 for ArcGIS 9.x

Requirements

NPS AlaskaPak for ArcGIS is designed to work with **ArcMap 9.2 and ArcMap 9.3** using Windows XP and

may not work correctly with earlier versions of ArcGIS or Windows. Additionally, the latest ESRI ArcGIS Service Pack is highly recommended, as they resolve many issues.

NPS AlaskaPak makes use of the windows registry on install to store application settings. To install AlaskaPak you will need administrator privileges, or have an administrator install it for you.

Installation Guide

What is Installed:

- AlaskaPak Toolbar – the NPS AlaskaPak toolbar will appear in ArcMap after installation. A dynamically linked library file (dll) is copied to install directory.
- AlaskaPak Help System – the AlaskaPak.chm help file is copied to the install directory.

Installation:

- Before beginning installation you must uninstall any previous versions of AlaskaPak and close any ArcMap sessions. **IMPORTANT NOTE IF YOU HAVE INSTALLED BETA VERSION 1: when uninstalling you will be prompted whether to remove shared files– select the REMOVE NONE option.**
- To install AlaskaPak download and launch the file: NPSAlaskaPakV2.2.exe You will be prompted for install location.
- The next time you open an ArcMap session the AlaskaPak toolbar will appear.
- Periodically, updates may be posted and your computer will routinely check for new versions of AlaskaPak. If a new version is available, you will be prompted whether you wish to update. You will need to exit ArcMap to run the update.
