
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Introduction

Compliance review of Inventory and Monitoring Program projects can be complicated for the uninitiated. This Standard Operating Procedure provides a flow chart describing the compliance review process used in Gates of the Arctic National Park and Preserve (GAAR). Note that this SOP pertains to GAAR only; projects intended for the Western Arctic Parklands should seek guidance from their compliance officer). The following diagram is an overview of the process and should provide a starting point for initiating the review process. Investigators should consult the GAAR compliance officer with questions or to obtain more in-depth information.
