




Web Enabled GIS – Integrated Data Mining

► ShoreZone Database



- Discover where Bull Kelp occurs.
- View and download aerial photos of Bull Kelp.
- Make and download regional maps of this kelp's distribution.

► Shore Station Database



- Query for all ground stations with Bull Kelp.
- View ground level photos of the nearshore habitat where this kelp occurs.
- Get species lists and click on hypertext to learn more about a species.


► Data Dictionary



- Search dictionary for Bull kelp.
- Find ShoreZone's definition of the bioband Nereocystis (NER).
- Click on hypertexts to learn more about this kelp and its associated species.

Where and what is the canopy forming kelp *Nereocystis leutkeana* or Bull Kelp?


